



# COVID Related Summer Program FAQ's

**Q: What days and hours will the Boys & Girls Club be open?**

**A:** Monday through Friday, 7:30 AM – 6:00 PM.

**Q: How will members be selected to attend the Club?**

**A:** We are only able to welcome currently enrolled families. Members will be selected by age, starting with the youngest members first. There is a chance that families with multiple children may not receive spots for all youth within their household. We will notify you via phone or email with a response by Thursday, May 21<sup>st</sup>.

**Q: Will all members be able to attend the Boys & Girls Club this summer?**

**A:** Because we will be gradually adding younger members back first into the Club and restricted in the number of members we can serve at this time, there is a chance your child may not be attending this summer. If you are not selected for our June 1<sup>st</sup> start date you will be placed on a waiting list for future openings. We will continue to review all CDC and local healthcare officials recommendations to update our protocols as needed.

**Q: Will meals still be provided?**

**A:** Yes, all members participating in the summer program will receive a breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack in the facility. We will also be offering a FREE meal program (Grab-N-Go) which will be open to **ALL** community youth ages 1-18 years old. Each child will receive a free lunch and free breakfast meal daily from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. They do NOT have to be Club members to receive the meals. **Q: Should I send my child with a Club Card?**

**A:** No, Club cards will not be used at this time.

**Q: Will Arrow Prep and Kidscope programs be offered?**

**A:** Arrow Prep (ages 3-5 years) will be open for members beginning June 1st. Kidscope will not be operating this summer. Current Kidscope enrollees will have the opportunity to apply for the new summer program and will need to complete the summer enrollment application.

**Q: My child is already a member, do I need to pay a fee?**

**A:** If your child is a current Club member, no, this service will be provided at no additional cost. Members transitioning from Kidscope will need to complete a Club membership application and pay the \$25 annual fee. Arrow Prep fees will remain at the normal rate.

**Q: I have already completed a parent orientation. Will I need to complete parent orientation?**

**A:** Yes. The Boys & Girls Club has implemented enhanced protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19, and all parents selected for the summer program will need to complete a phone orientation to review these new protocols.

**Q: Will you continue to provide Virtual Programming throughout summer?**
